Good health leads to better learning. For this purpose:

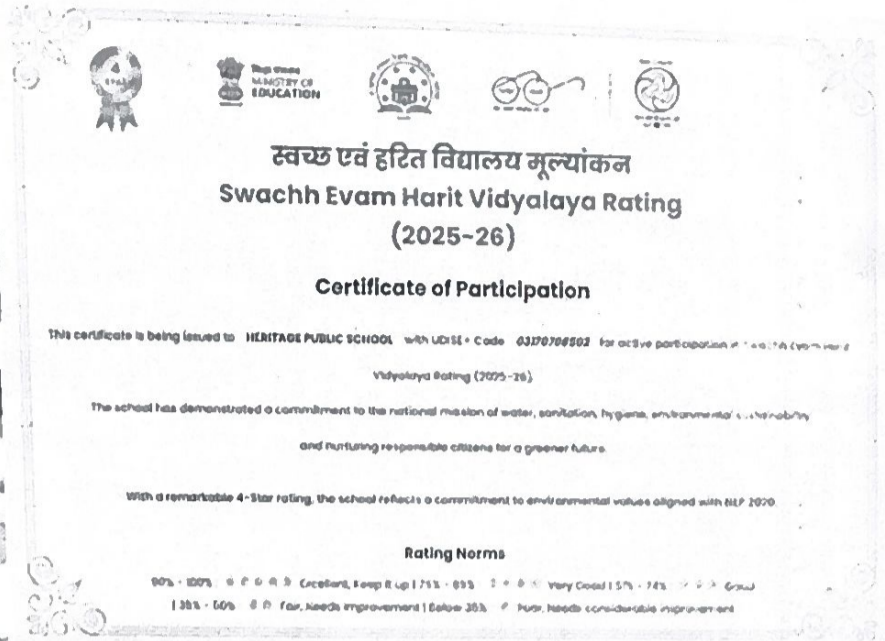
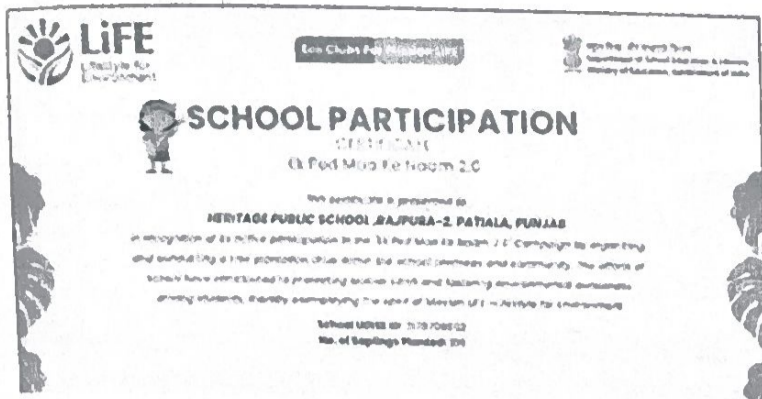
1. Regular health check-ups were conducted for students, staff and community members.

Students were selected for zonal/ cluster-level CBSE Tournaments.

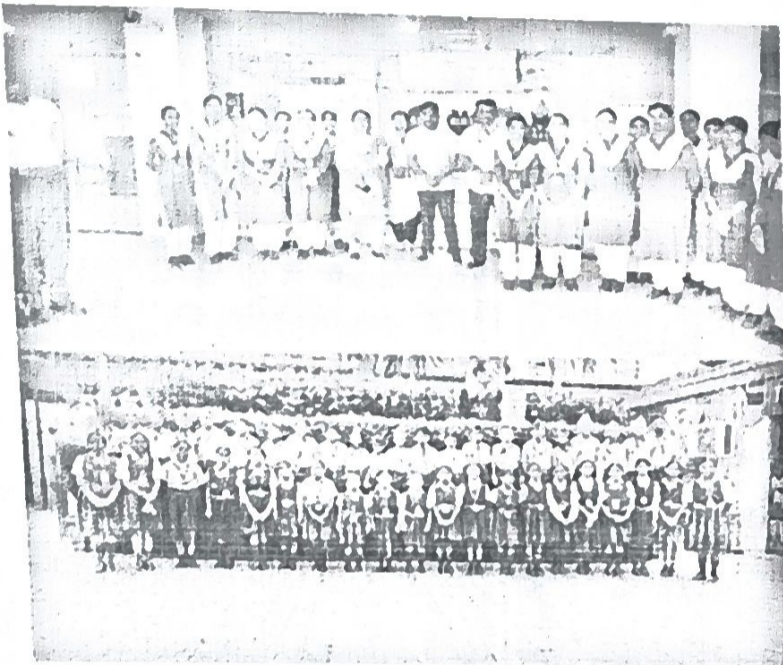
1. Amanjot Kaur won gold medal in Triple Jump at CBSE Cluster XVII Games.
